	When God uses natural circumstances to bring about His supernatural will.
	Now Boaz had gone up to the gate and sat down there. And behold, the redeemer, of whom Boaz had spoken came by. So Boaz said, "Turn aside, friend; sit down here." And he turned aside and sat down. Ruth 4:1 ESV
	The providence of God is like reading Hebrew; it is best understood
2.	Strategic P
	So I thought I would tell you of it and say, 'Buy it in the presence of those sitting here and in the presence of the elders of my people.' If you will redeem it, redeem it. But if you will not, tell me, that I may know, for there is no one besides you to redeem it, and I come after you." And he said, "I will redeem it." Then Boaz said, "The day you buy the field from the hand of Naomi, you also acquire Ruth the Moabite, the widow of the dead, in order to perpetuate the name of the dead in his inheritance." Then the redeemer said, "I cannot redeem it." Ruth 4:4-6 ESV lest I impair my own inheritance. Take my right of redemption yourself, for I cannot redeem it."
